Indianapolis

Try the "Miles Ahead" Performance Motoring School, where you'll learn how to drive a MINI Cooper on the IMS Formula 1 course. It's best for those who stick to the speed limit. bemilesahead.net

Strap on your helmet and get in the passenger's seat for a wild, high-speed ride in a two-person race car, achieving speeds of up to 180 miles per hour as you circle the famous track. indianapolismotorspeedway.com

The Indy Racing Experience Driving program allows you to get behind the wheel of an IndyCar that's been raced in the Indianapolis 500. indyracingexperience.com





Sure, Beaver Creek has its famously terrifying World Cup trail, Birds of Prey. But it also has the best kids' school in the country, along with a wide variety of beginner slopes. Plus, warm chocolate chip cookies are handed out at the base after your last run. beginnersek.com

As the country's largest ski resort, with over 5,000 acres of terrain, there's plenty at Vail for everyone. Intermediates should head to Blue Sky Basin, a lightly gladed, incredibly scenic area just past the resort's famous backside bowls. vail.com

When there's enough snow to stick to Arapahoe Basin's East Wall, expect to see local daredevils hiking up to the top of the 13,050-foot peak to conquer the terrifyingly steep slopes of some of the highest in-bounds ski terrain in North America. arapahoebasin.com







Visit Homosassa Springs Wildlife State Park for guaranteed views of four resident manatees. There's also an underwater observatory featuring three daily manatee programs. floridastateparks.org

Rent kayaks from local tour operators and head up the Crystal River to Three Sisters Springs, where manatees often swim alongside you as you paddle. floridakayakcompany.com

Slip into a wetsuit and snorkel or dive the Crystal River waters, where some friendly manatees are known to approach divers in search of scratches to remove their copious algae.







Go up, up and away in a beautiful hot air balloon with Air Texas Balloon Adventures, taking to the skies above the Katy area for gorgeous views of the Gulf Coast sunrise. airtexasballoon.com

Want to feel the freedom of flight? Tandem hang gliding requires minimal instruction, and companies like Sportations will take you high above city sights like the Houston Space Center. sportations.com

If "tandem" sounds too tame, Houston's Solo Flight Training offers just what its name implies: a one-hour class that ends with you taking the controls of a plane for a bird's eye view of the city. soloflighttraining.com



GET WET IN JAMAICA

Take a romantic three-mile bamboo raft ride down Trelawney's lazy Martha Brae River, stopping for a swim and a rope swing at Tarzan's Corner. jamaicarafting.com

If you prefer to spend your day in the water rather than on it, grab your snorkeling gear and head to aquatic hotspots like Doctor's Cave Beach in MoBay, St. Elizabeth's Treasure Beach, or Runaway Bay.

Climb 600 feet up Dunn's River Falls, Jamaica's No. 1 tourist attraction, with protruding rock ledges that create a series of natural stairs and rock slides. Careful, it's surprisingly slippery! dunnsriverfallsja.com







SAIL CHESAPEAKE BAY

From romantic sunset floats aboard 74foot schooners to kid-friendly pirate cruises, a host of different operators run half-, full- and multi-day tours of the picturesque bay out of Annapolis. cruisesonthebay.com

FLY WITH BLUE ANGELS AT THE NATIONAL NAVAL AVIATION MUSEUM

RAFT THE JAMES RIVER

Looking for a lazy day on the water?

James River Reeling and Rafting offers two to four hour tubing trips down a serene, secluded stretch of the Richmond-area river.

If you're a canoeing/kayaking newbie, the river's upper section offers miles of mild waters ranging from Class I to II, with opportunities for fishing along the way.

Those seeking more of a River Wild-type adrenaline rush will want to head for the lower section of the James, the only urban river in America with challenging Class III to IV rapids.







On a horseback ride at Rancho Caribeño, a guide will lead you along tropical white sand beaches with pastoral views of the Punta Cana countryside. puntacana.com

Take a 4x4 ride through Indigenous Eyes Ecological Park, exploring a private reserve of nature trails and crystal-clear freshwater lagoons. just-tours.net

A Dune Buggy Adventure allows you to get behind the wheel for a nine-hour trek starting at Unero Alto. Race through rice fields near Nissibon and the beaches of Playa La Vacama and meet locals along the way. puntacanatours.com
